(Oct. 4, 1922 - April 28, 1962) was an Italian pediatrician, wife, and mother who refused both an abortion and a hysterectomy when she was pregnant with her fourth child, despite knowing that continuing with the pregnancy could result in her death. She was canonized as a saint in 2004.
