DECREE OF DECONSECRATION AND REDUCTION OF THE PARISH CHURCH OF THE SACRED HEART IN FRANKLIN, MINNESOTA

- 1. Having carefully considered the law and the facts; and
- 2. Having consulted and heard the Presbyteral Council on April 19, 2019; and
- 3. Having heard on November 18, 2019 the Reverend Pastor and members of the Parish of the Sacred Heart, in whose territory the aforesaid property is situated; and
- 4. Having ensured that the altar, sacred objects and religious artifacts have been removed from the church; and
- 5. Having provided that the good of souls will suffer no unnecessary detriment, that is, the spiritual and pastoral care of the parishioners who formerly worshipped at the Church of the Sacred Heart in Franklin is now being provided by the Parish of St. Catherine in Redwood Falls, Minnesota;

I, the undersigned Bishop of New Ulm do hereby decree that the parish church of the Sacred Heart, located on East Main Street, in Franklin, Minnesota, is no longer a sacred place for divine worship. It has herewith lost its blessing, dedication, and consecration. It can no longer be used for divine worship, in anticipation of its demolition. It is hereto relegated to profane but not sordid use, in accord with canon 1222 § 2 of the *Code of Canon Law*.

This decree is to be communicated to the Reverend Pastor of the Parish of St. Catherine in Redwood Falls, who is the canonical representative of the parish, according to the norm of law found in canon 532.
